Fertility

- Soil test at beginning and end of season
- Ammonium Sulfate @1/2 lb rate applied in April and October
- Roots 15-3-8 @¹/₄ lb rate applied May, June, July and September

Pesticide Applications

- May and June backpack applications of Trimec Classic
- July Merit and Up Star insecticides applied in addition to a low rate application of Acclaim for crabgrass control
- August Banvel and a low rate of Acclaim are applied
- September Turf Enhancer(TGR) is applied at 16oz per acre rate to control annual bluegrass growth and allow new seed to germinate
- Early December Poa Constrictor(Ethofumesate) is applied @ 24
 oz per acre rate for annual bluegrass control

Aerification

- Verti-drain with ¾ in solid tines in April and September
- During the course of the season(July, Aug, Sept) slice aerated with Aerway 5 times to relieve compaction

Seed Rates *

- 2150lbs kentucky bluegrass(Prosperity, Midnight II) seeded with seed-a-vator in Mid-May
- 450lbs perennial rye(Revenge, Citation Fore, Grand Slam) broadcast seeded early June
- 2150lbs perennial rye(Manhattan 5, Citation Fore, Brightstar) seeded with seed-a-vator mid-July after season starts
- 1600lbs perennial rye(Silver Dollar, Citation Fore, Brightstar) broadcast seeded after field showed signs of wear in

- Mid-August
- 2400lbs kentucky bluegrass(Midnight Star, Midnight II, Prosperity, Avalanche) seeded with seed-a-vator after field had been top dressed
- 500lbs kentucky bluegrass(Midnight Star, Midnight II, Prosperity, Avalanche) broadcast seeded after aeration in Late September
- *Seed was custom blended for us through our supplier

Irrigation

- Watered only as needed in spring and fall to encourage root growth and slow annual bluegrass
- During summer months of the polo season we watered at least 3x per week @ ½ in per application, in order to maintain a competitive surface for polo and to allow the field to heal without drying out

Mowing

- Field was mowed at least 3x a week @ 1in. from April to November(with the exception of September when the field had been sprayed with TGR)
- Field was mowed with a Jacobsen AR-5 rotary mower April/May and a Jacobsen LF-5 in June. We mowed with a rotary mower in April and May to keep the stalky ryegrass cut clean then switched over to reel mowing as the season approached
- Field was mowed the rest of the season with a 7-gang tow behind reel unit @ 1in.

Field Repair

- Field had 16 games played on it during the season, after each game divots were picked up or put back if still attached(process takes between 3-4 hours)
- End of year repairs consisted of: sweeping the field, topdressing with 32 tons of 8-1-1 divot mix to repair surface,
